Dredging Program


We have examined the tenders submitted by Sceptre Dredging Ltd. and Dillingham Corporation Canada Ltd. for the above project and recommend award of this contract to the low bidder, Sceptre Dredging Ltd.

The tendered price of \$260,693.00 is approximately 4% above that which was indicated in our letter dated March 5, 1970. It was, however, 30% higher than the price indicated by the President of Sceptre Dredging Ltd. in his letter to Mr. Ramsill, Chairman, Summer Games Committee, dated November 20, 1970.

Additional work required to dredge beneath the 42-inch Greater Vancouver Water District water main which crosses the lake in the vicinity of Piper Avenue will be undertaken by Greater Vancouver Water District forces in the fall of this year. The cost of this extra work is estimated to be \$7500.

It is anticipated that approval of the only outstanding application for "Approval to Dredge," made on behalf of the Municipality, will be forthcoming from the Water Rights Branch, Department of Lands, Forests and Water Resources in the immediate future.
