Further statistics are now being kept in the area of daily intake, e.g. the number of persons coming into the Department seeking some form of assistance and being seen by one of the four permanent intake workers who are on duty from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., five days a week.

During the month of October, 1970, 675 persons were seen—an average of approximately 32 per day. November, 1970, 625 persons—an average of 31 per day. December, 1970, 643 persons—an average of 29 per day. The highest number of persons seen on any one day during this three month period totalled 46. The lowest number seen was 19.

As of June, 1970, we are now keeping records as to the number of persons seeking aid who have recently arrived from other provinces in Canada. During the period October, 1970 to December, 1970, 215 such persons were seen.

UNEMPLOYABLE PERSONS

The unemployable category consists of those persons who because of various social and medical factors, e.g. widowed, aged, misc. disabilities, etc. cannot be considered as employable.
