

3. Re: Proposed Local Improvement Project --
Grange-Dover, Kingsway to Royal Oak Avenue.
(Item 19, Manager's Report No. 47, July 26, 1971).

In Item 19, the Manager reported that the above project would also involve the construction of certain water works at an estimated cost of \$16,000 and sanitary sewer reconstruction for the West Burnaby system at an estimated cost of \$65,000.

The Engineer has now completed the design for the reconstruction of the sanitary sewer on Grange Street and he has found that it is necessary to reconstruct almost twice as much sanitary sewer as was originally intended. The reason for this increase in reconstruction is to avoid later reconstruction of an existing sanitary sewer on Kingsway. To avoid the excessive problem which would be encountered in connection with reconstructing a sewer on Kingsway, the Engineer has extended the reconstruction on Grange Street parallel to Kingsway as far east as Sussex, and as a result the new estimate for reconstruction of sanitary sewer on Grange Street is \$143,000.

This amount has been included in Application No. 4 under the Federal Provincial Employment Loans Program which was considered by Council last week.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council authorize the reconstruction of the sewer as recommended by the Engineer; and
THAT it be financed by the Federal Provincial Employment Loans Program.
