13. Re: Burnaby Road-closing Bylaw No. 6, 1971 (#5901)
Closure of Portions of Buckingham Avenue,
Wallen Avenue, Braemar Avenue and Adjacent Lanes.

Council authorized the Planning Department to initiate the above Road-Closing as part of the process of creating a proposed church site in D.L. 86. The Bylaw to rezone the site (Rezoning Reference #14/71) was not pursued by Council and an alternate site is being considered.

We suggest that it would be appropriate to continue with the Road-Closing procedure as the subject roads will have to be closed in the future as part of the implementation of the D.L. 86 Development Plan in particular to provide for the development of the major park. Recognizing the above and in light of the expense incurred so far on plans and documents, it would be logical to proceed with the closings at this time.

The Road-Closing Bylaw will therefore appear before Council for its consideration on August 9, 1971.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council proceed with the Road-Closing Bylaw.
