12. Re: Federal Manpower and Immigration - Local Initiatives Program, Province of B.C. - Job Opportunities Program. (Item 14, Report No. 71, Supplementary, November 8, 1971)

As reported to Council, Manager's report item #14, 8 November 1971, on 3 November 1971, the Municipal Treasurer filed the following Local Initiatives programs for approval of Provincial and Federal authorities:

	Cleaning ditches throughout Burnaby	Landscaping in Parks
Number of Job Opportunity men to be employed	30	20
Total estimated cost of project	\$137,884	\$112,968
Federal grant	94,770	63,180
Provincial grant	34,098	22,732
Burnaby's cost	9,016	27,056

These were immediately approved by the Province and sent on to Manpower. It was 13 December before the first application was approved by Manpower and 17 December before Burnaby's parks project was approved. It was approved with a Federal grant of \$60,840 for the period 1 December 1971 to 31 May 1972.

Recruitment began immediately (men from welfare rolls) and the project commenced 28 December 1971. Since funds were approved from 1 December, permission was sought and received from Manpower to increase the number of men to be employed from 20 to 23.

The ditch program has not been approved to date. On enquiring as to its progress, the Municipal Treasurer was informed that it was one of the less attractive projects before the Committee concerned and that it was un-likely that it would be approved.
