

19. Re: Letter from Mr. E. McKnight,
6180 Irmin Street Regarding
Vancouver Auto Auctions
6146 Beresford Street

Appearing on the Agenda for the January 10, 1972 meeting is a letter dated December 17, 1971 from Mr. E. McKnight complaining about noise from Vancouver Auto Auctions, 6146 Beresford Street.

The Chief Public Health Inspector advises that he has taken the following action:

" A letter of complaint was received December 28, 1971. Investigation revealed that the company complained of holds a weekly auction of automobiles and that the next auction would be held on January 5, 1972, at which time we planned to take noise readings. In the meantime, the matter was discussed by telephone with both the principal of the concerned operation and the complainant.

On January 5, 1972 the first of our proposed noise readings were taken. A further telephone discussion took place between this Department, an official of the concerned business and the complainant. The complainant stated that the noise was much less and the company has stated that they will do everything possible to see that the noise emissions are maintained at an acceptable level. The company has requested advice from this Department as to how they might make further improvement and we have agreed to assist in this matter.

We do not anticipate difficulty in finalizing this matter but will advise you should complications develop."
