17. Re: Letter - Mr. and Mrs. G. Woodcock - dated September 26, 1972
Public Works Yard at Willingdon And Canada Way

Appearing on the Agenda for the October 10, 1972, Council Meeting is a letter from Mr. and Mrs. G. Woodcock concerning the appearance of the Public Works Yard at Willingdon and Canada Way.

A. The generally unattractive appearance of the Works Yard may be due to the fact that the Provincial Highway Department has for sometime been looking for an alternative site, in order to move from this prime site, which should properly be developed as part of the B.C.I.T. - B.C.V.S. complex.

The Municipal Planning Department has proposed several alternative sites to the Highway Department, and is prepared to continue working with the Province on this subject. However, it is likely that locating a new site will take some time, and it therefore appears reasonable that in the meanwhile screening and landscaping should be provided.

B. Imperial Street is in this year's Stage I Local Improvement street projects and as such will most definitely receive overlay and surface course pavement. The overlay paving work is scheduled for commencement on Wednesday, October 11, 1972, and providing weather conditions are suitable, will be completed by the end of that week.

The Engineer has personally driven Buckingham Drive between Burris and Sperling and has found that the major portion of the street is in excellent condition but that the portion between Haszard and Burris will require re-shaping and repaving when a curb is installed on the south side. In the meantime, there are no pot holes or other serious problems and normal maintenance will ensure the adequacy of the street.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the Highway Department be requested to provide screening and landscaping of their works yard at Canada Way and Willingdon, at least to the standard required by the Burnaby Zoning Bylaw, and preferably to the standard set by the adjacent Provincial development; and

THAT a copy of this report be sent to Mr. and Mrs. G. Woodcock.
