COUNCIL MEETING Sept. 11/72

10. Re: Closing of Delta Avenue north of Still Creek Avenue,
Rezoning #84/71: Inter-City Express Exchange Proposal
(Item 2, Report No. 79 (In Camera) Meeting December 6, 1971)
(Item 12, Report No. 82, Meeting December 20, 1971.)

Council on December 6, 1971, authorized the Planning Department to convey a 3.2 acre site on the north side of Still Creek Avenue to Inter-City Express in exchange for property which Inter-City Express owned on Winston Street. Council on December 20, 1971, authorized the introduction of a road-Closing By-Law to close Delta Avenue north of Still Creek Street and south of the Burlington Northern Right-of-Way. This portion of the road will be part of the 3.2 acre site to be acquired by Inter-City Express (see attached sketch).

A B.C. Hydro pole line runs through the north 80 feet of the lots on either side of Delta Avenue at the location closed by By-Law No. 6108.

Victoria has granted an Order-in-Council vesting title in the Road to the Municipality on the understanding that this easement would be extended over the closed road allowance.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT authorization be given to grant an easement to B. C. Hydro and Power Authority over the portion of road closed and shown as cross-hatched on the attached sketch.
