

22. Re: Letter - W.S. Adams, 6867 Broadway Sidewalk Crossings

Appearing on the Agenda for the August 14, 1972 Council Meeting is a letter from W.S. Adams objecting to abandonment of the driveway crossings at the subject location.

The Municipal Engineer advises that the reasons for denying a driveway crossing that would provide access to the present driveway locations (see <u>attached</u> sketch) are as follows:

- 1. The entire loop section of the driveway is outside the property and is located on the municipal boulevard.
- 2. The westerly leg of the loop crosses into the boulevard frontage of the property next door and will be connecting to their driveway. If this was permitted, it could be a source of complaint from the owner of 6845 Broadway either now or in the future.
- 3. Driving along a boulevard except when entering directly into a property on an approved driveway is a violation of Section 191, Provincial Motor Vehicle Act.

In view of the above, the Engineer seeks Council's concurrence that only one vehicle crossing in approximate alignment with applicant's main driveway be permitted.


RECOMMENDATION:
