Re: Interviews for Outside Consultant for
Design of Kensington Park Skating Rink

Four interviews with selected consultants were conducted, three on Friday, P.M., April 21, 1972, the fourth at noon, Tuesday, April 25, 1972.

Criteria employed by the Committee in the conduct of the interviews included:

- previous similar or related design experience of consultant;
- attitude of consultant on design of a rink in North Burnaby;
- major components deemed essential by consultant to a community skating rink;
- experience of consultant with current skating rink construction costs.

From the presentation/interviews of the four consultants, it was the unanimous decision of the Committee that the firm of Carlberg Jackson Partners most closely met the Committee's criteria for the skating rink design, and it is the recommendation of the Committee that the said firm be engaged.

The staff consultant/coordinator agrees with the Committee's assessment of the interviews and concurs with the Committee recommendation.
