3. Re: Lane Between Denbigh Avenue and Elgin Avenue  
From Oakland Street South to the South P.L.  
of Lot 5, S.D. 4, D.L. 94, Plan 10673

On September 25, 1972, Council received from the Municipal Clerk a Certificate of Sufficiency covering the construction and paving of the subject lane as a local improvement by the petition method.

Following is a cost report which is required by Section 601 of the of the Municipal Act and which is supplied by the Treasurer:

Length of work	425	feet
Estimated cost of work	\$ 3,400	
Actual frontage	595.32	feet
Taxable frontage	589.32	feet
Owner's share of the cost of the work	\$ 589.32	
Estimated lifetime of the work	10	years
Frontage tax levy	5 installments of \$.257	per taxable front foot

The Engineer has already advised Jack Cewe Limited in writing that the paving only of the lane should be added to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract 1972, Contract #16. (See Report Item 14, Report 62, October 2, 1972). Paving only of the lane is estimated to cost approximately \$750. The balance of the work involving reconstruction will be carried out by Municipal forces under our current practice.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the cost report be received; and

THAT a construction by-law be brought forward; and

THAT the Engineer's decision to add the paving of the lane to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract, 1972, Contract #16, be ratified.
