MANAGER'S REPORT NO. 66

COUNCIL MEETING Oct. 16/72

5. Re: Lane Between Hardwick Street and Woodsworth Street
From Douglas Road to Godwin Avenue

On October 2, 1972, Council received from the Municipal Clerk a Certificate of Sufficiency covering the construction and paving of the subject lane as a local improvement by the petition method.

Following is a cost report which is required by Section 601 of the Municipal Act and which is supplied by the Treasurer:

Length of work	750	feet
Estimated cost of work	\$ 2,700.00	
Actual frontage	1,409.00	feet
Taxable frontage	1,386.00	feet
Owner's share of the cost of the work	\$ 1,386.00	
Estimated lifetime of the work	10	years
Frontage tax levy	5 installments of \$.257	per taxable front foot

The Engineer requests authority to add the paving of the lane to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract 1972, Contract #16. The estimated cost of paving the lane is \$1,300. The balance of the work involving reconstruction of the base will be carried out by Municipal forces as is our customary practice.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the cost report be received; and

THAT a construction by-law be brought forward; and

THAT the paving only of the lane be added to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract 1972, Contract #16.
