It is now time to reimburse general revenue by an appropriation from the tax sale moneys fund.

This is in accordance with a procedure approved by Council on 21 December, 1970, in that properties for land assembly purposes would be purchased as offered if the price was right and from time to time general revenue would be reimbursed upon the passage of a tax sale moneys by-law.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT a tax sale moneys by-law be brought down to appropriate \$206,574.81 to reimburse general revenue for the moneys expended on the lands cited above.
