COUNCIL MEETING Apr. 17/72

8. Re: Unsightly Premises - 4146 Lozells Avenue
(Item 13, Report No. 21, March 27, 1972)

Mr. A. W. Smallwood, Vice President and General Manager of Bingham Pump Company Limited, in a letter dated March 15, 1972, complained about the storage of steel drums on the subject property. Council on March 27, 1972, was informed that an investigation had been started.

The Chief Public Health Inspector advises that the subject property was inspected on March 30, 1972, and found to be in contravention of Unsightly Premises Bylaw #5533.

The Health Department received a letter dated April 10, 1972, from the joint owners and managing partners of the subject property. The letter contained a commitment to have all materials cleared from the property by May 30, 1972.

If the property is cleared in accordance with the commitment, no further report concerning this matter will be referred to Council.
