REMARKS:

During the month there were two murders in Burnaby. One involved the death of an elderly widow who lived alone in North Burnaby. She was found lying in her kitchen with severe head injuries apparently caused by blows from a blunt instrument. She died in hospital two days later. No motive has been established, but the matter is still under active investigation.

The second murder victim was a 21-year-old woman who was sexually assaulted and brutally killed in the 5500 block Kingsway. A 16-year-old juvenile has been charged with this murder and is presently in custody awaiting trial.

Two extortion attempts, each involving the sum of \$10,000.00, were directed at a local bank manager during the month. On one occasion he received a phone call to deliver \$10,000.00, and the second attempt was in form of a note upbraiding him for failing to respond to the first attempt and ordering him to deliver \$10,000.00 with the threat that his wife or daughter would disappear. A 25-year-old Montreal man has been arrested and charged with both offences.

Also in the more serious crime category, a 27-year-old man was arrested and charged with the rape of an 18-year-old Vancouver girl. The offence occurred in a motel in Burnaby after the victim accompanied the man to the motel for a few drinks.
