21. Re: Letter dated July 6, 1972, from Mr. Rogers
Trees and Boulevard at 6596 Marlborough

The Engineer advises that Superintendent L. Francis is currently on vacation so we are unable to determine with certainty that he had made arrangements to replace the trees and restore the boulevard. However, we have no reason whatsoever to dispute Mr. Rogers' statement and indeed feel that his request is reasonable and is in general conformity with the Corporation's standard practice to replace boulevard improvements disrupted during construction.

The General Superintendent has now officially requested that the Parks Department restore the boulevard as soon as possible and furthermore to provide and replant replacement trees at a time suitable for such work, but again as soon as practicable.

RECOMMENDATION:
