25. Re: Letter - Mr. and Mrs. Furlani, 6557 - 12th Avenue
Unightly Premises

Appearing on the Agenda for the July 17, 1972 Council Meeting is a letter from Mr. and Mrs. Furlani protesting the alleged unsightly premises of a neighbor, Mr. G. Jones.

The Chief Public Health Inspector advises that the premises belonging to Mr. Jones has on numerous occasions over a period of years been the source of complaint and countercomplaint. A great deal of Municipal time has consequently been spent in attempting to finalize this situation.

The Chief Public Health Inspector believes that the matter will not be satisfactorily reviewed until a full and comprehensive report is presented to Council. The report which he is presently preparing will contain the following information:

1. Municipal action to date.
2. All past and current factors pertaining to the situation.
3. Present condition of the concerned property.
4. Recommendation(s).

The report will be submitted to Council on July 31, 1972.
