

8. Re: Street Lighting Design Services -- Area I  
From Lane North of Dundas to Lane South of  
Parker Street Between Willingdon Ave. and Boundary Rd.

The above-mentioned street lighting area is included in our Capital Improvement Program for local improvement initiation in 1972.

It is considered necessary at this time to obtain the street lighting design for two reasons:

1. The Municipal Clerk requires on file while initiating local improvement lighting projects, a plan showing the layout of the proposed lighting system so that he may satisfactorily answer enquiries regarding location of lamp standards and other features of the system.
2. Our Local Improvement Streets Program contains streets in this area, notably Parker Street, which should be predicted prior to street construction in order to avoid cutting across new pavements shortly after construction.

Accordingly the Engineer invited proposals from the two engineering firms who have done satisfactory work for us in the past in street lighting design to provide design services for this area. The following is the result of those proposals with both firms stating that fees for services would be in accordance with the scale of minimum fees set out by the Association of Professional Engineers of B.C. with maximum fee in each case not to exceed:

El-Sewaro Engineering Ltd. ....	\$8,425.
R.P. Shaflik Engineering Ltd.....	\$3,280.

Mr. Shaflik has done a great deal of engineering design for us in electrical work and does excellent work in this regard. His very attractive proposal results from his complete familiarity with our requirements and specifications.

The Engineer recommends that Council approval be sought to enter into the usual engineering contract with R.P. Shaflik Engineering Ltd.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT authority be given to execute an engineering contract with R.P. Shaflik Engineering Ltd. to provide street lighting engineering design services for the street lighting area from the lane north of Dundas Street to the lane south of Parker Street between Willingdon Ave. and Bounday Road in accordance with the Association of B.C. Professional Engineers minimum fees, with a firm maximum fee not to exceed \$3,280.00.
