12. Re: Local Improvement - Government Road

Phillips Avenue to Brighton Avenue

Before initiating the works on Govermment Road outlined in the Manager's Report No. 70 of 30 October 1972, it will be necessary to amend Burnaby Local Improvement Charges By-law 1.971, By-law No. 5858, to permit the construction of a $4^{\prime}$ walk as part of a 28' pavement with curbs project and to include bus pullovers in the description of the works, as follows:

1. $28^{\prime}$ pavements, curbs and gutters - with provision for bus pullovers
(a) Grading and roadbed preparation on existing streets, Portland cement concrete curbs and gutters on both sides of the street, asphaltic pavement not more than two inches in thickness to a width between curb faces of $28^{\prime}$ except for bus pullovers at approximate 1,200 foot intervals, on both sides of the street wherein the width shall be 36 feet for a distance or 124 feet for each pullover incluaing retaining walls, storm drainage facilities and boulevard restoration incidental thereto.
(b) $\$ .75$ per taxable front foot in fifteen annual instalments except that where a pavement is aiready in piace for which local improvement charges are currently being paia, the annual rate shall be rediced by $\$ .37$ to the affected owners oniy, and where a four foot sidewalk is already in place for which local improvenent charges are currently being paid, the cnnual charge shall be reduced by a furtiner $\$ .37$ to the affected owners only.
2. 28' pavements, curbs and gutters with a separated four ioot sidewalk constructed on one side of the street only - with provision for bus pullovers
(a) Grading and roadbed preparation on existing streets, Portland cement concrete curbs and gutters on both sides of the street, asphaltic pavement not more than two inches in thickness to a width between curb faces of $28^{\prime}$ except for bus pullovers at approximate 1,200 ioot intervals on both sides of the street werein the wiath shail be 36 feet for a distance 0 f 124 ieet for each pullover, including retaining walls, storm drainege facilities and poulevard restoration incidental thereto and a four foot concrete sidewalk separated inon the curbing on one side $O \vec{i}$ the street woxk only.
(b) $\$ .75$ per taxable front foot in fifteen annual instalments to properties abuting curbs only and $\$ 1.12$ per taxable front foot
in fifteen annual instalments to properties abutting the curoing vitu separated four foct sideraik oniy, eneept thed where a pavement is already in ploce for wnich local improvement charges are curantly being jail, the banal jete shell be reduced by $\$ .37$ to the offected properties only, and where a four foot siciewaik is alreudy in place for which local improvenent charges are curcently being paid, the annual charge shell be reduced by a further $\$ .37$ to the affected owners only.
