8. Re: Letter from Mrs. M. Forsyth dated May 17, 1972
Burnaby Noise Pollution Bylaw

Appearing on the Agenda for the May 29, 1972, Council meeting is a letter dated May 17, 1972, from Mrs. M. Forsyth referring to a noise problem with motorcycles.

The Burnaby Noise Pollution Bylaw which was passed sometime ago does not become effective until June 1, 1972.

The noise made by motorcycles, as complained of by Mrs. Forsyth is, in our opinion, a police matter under the Motor Vehicle Act, Section 7A.01 - i.e. loud and unnecessary noise from motor vehicle.

Complaints of this nature will be the subject of further investigation when the Bylaw becomes effective. There may be more than one way to handle them.

RECOMMENDATION:
