14. Re: Letter - Coquitlam Chamber of Commerce North Road

Appearing on the Agenda for the May 29, 1972, Council meeting is a letter dated May 15, 1972, from the Coquitlam Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber requests that the Municipality of Burnaby include in its study of North Road an evaluation of light and signal installations at three specified locations on the thoroughfare.

Reference is made in the letter to a study of North Road being under progress. The Municipal Engineer advises that the word "study" is really not correct as the Municipality has only considered specific points of concern from a traffic point of view and these have been referred to and have been dealt with by the Traffic Safety Committee, each on its own merit.

All three points raised by the Coquitlam Chamber of Commerce should be referred to the Traffic Safety Committee for the sake of continuity of investigations conducted to date. The latter two points in particular have been previously investigated and should be investigated in that light.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the letter from the Coquitlam Chamber of Commerce be referred to the Traffic Safety Committee for investigation and report to the Council; and

THAT a copy of this report be sent to the Coquitlam Chamber of Commerce.
