COUNCIL MEETING Oct. 30/72

10. Re: Lane East of and Parallel to Pritchard Street
North From Caswell Street to the N.P.L. Lot 1,
Block 5, D.L.s 6/8/56, Plan 17068

On October 23, 1972, Council received from the Municipal Clerk a Certificate of Sufficiency covering the construction and paving of the subject lane as a local improvement by the petition method.

Following is a cost report which is required by Section 601 of the Municipal Act and which is supplied by the Treasurer:

The Engineer requests authority to add the paving of the lane to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract 1972, Contract #16. The estimated cost of paving the lane is \$475. The balance of the work involving construction of the base will be carried out by Municipal forces as has been the customary practice.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the cost report be received; and

THAT a construction by-law be brought forward; and

THAT the paving only of the lane be added to Asphaltic Concrete Supply Contract 1972, Contract #16.
