Re: Dog Control - Simon Fraser University Grounds

Simon Fraser University officials are experiencing difficulty in the control of dogs running at large, primarily because they lack authority to seize animals pending the arrival of the S.P.C.A. truck. By the time the truck is summoned and arrives at the scene, the dogs have generally dispersed.

The Corporation has a contract with the S.P.C.A. appointing that organization the poundkeeper for Burnaby. In discussions with the S.P.C.A. and the Director of Ancillary Services, Simon Fraser University, the Chief Licence Inspector has determined that the problem may be overcome if the Director of Ancillary Services is empowered to impound dogs. The S.P.C.A. could appoint this gentleman as a member of its staff, but it would rather not do so. They would, though, be agreeable to having him appointed by the Corporation as Poundkeeper with jurisdiction over the Simon Fraser University site, with power to appoint his own staff and they will take delivery of dogs so impounded.

Mr. G. Suart, Vice-President, Administration, Simon Fraser University, has made a formal request that this be done on a trial basis.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the Director of Ancillary Services for Simon Fraser University (currently Mr. C. A. Buchanan) be appointed as Poundkeeper in the area of Burnaby owned by Simon Fraser University, with duties and responsibilities as prescribed in Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound By-law 1969, By-law No. 5556.

THAT he serve without pay.
