

6. Re: Unsightly Premises - 3777 Eton Street  
(Formerly 3775 Eton Street)  
(Item 9, Report No. 44, July 4, 1972)

Appearing on the Agenda for the July 4, 1972 meeting was a petition concerning unsightly conditions on the subject property.

The Chief Public Health Inspector advised that the premises were inspected on June 26, 1972, and found to be in contravention of Burnaby Unsightly Premises By-Law No. 5533. An unsightly premises notice was sent to the owner directing him to correct the conditions and bring the premises into compliance with the By-Law by July 10, 1972.

Council was advised at the time that a subsequent report would be forthcoming if the premises were not brought into conformance with By-Law No. 5533 by July 10, 1972.

The Chief Public Health Inspector now advises that we will be proceeding by court action to bring these premises into conformity with the By-Law as the owner has not improved the site.
