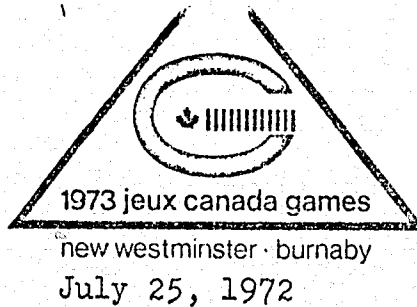
16. Re: Canada Summer Games

The following letter dated July 25, 1972, has been received from the Canada Summer Games Society requesting authority for a fly-past for the above.

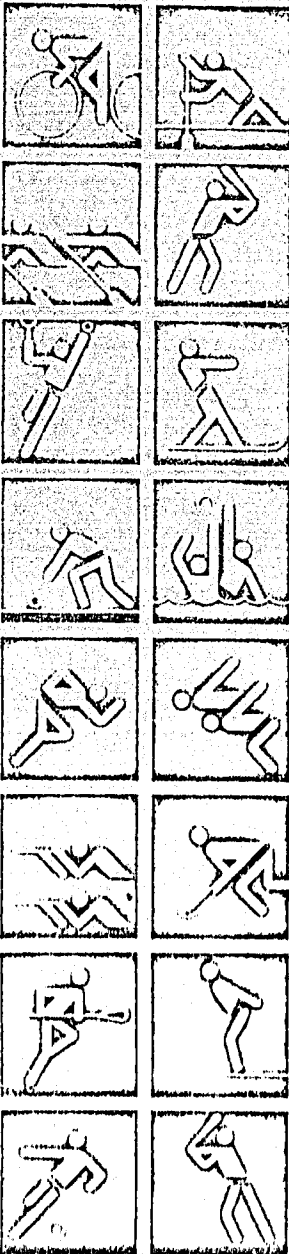
RECOMMENDATION:

As part of the Countdown 73 ceremonies August 3, the Canada Summer Games has planned an R.C.A.F. fly pass at approximately 11 A.M.

The fly pass would consist of 4, 101 - jet fighter aircraft from Comox. The flight plan would be 2 passes over Burnaby and New Westminister at an altitude of 500 to 1000 feet.

The fly pass will be timed to occur at the presentation of the official games scroll to Mayors Evers and Prittie at the Canada Games office.

Would the Council of Burnaby please give favorable consideration to approving this and direct the necessary approval to the Ministry of Transport; 793 West Hastings, attention Mr. Gill.
