

14. Re: Contract #13 - Tenders - Sidewalk - Moscrop and Willingdon

Tenders for the subject proposal were received up to 3:00 p.m., local time, on Wednesday, March 29, 1972.

The work includes the supply and installation of concrete sidewalks and road paving materials on (1) Moscrop Drive from Willingdon Avenue to Royal Oak Avenue, and (2) Willingdon Avenue from Lougheed Highway to Willingdon Overpass.

Approximate quantities are as follows:

- 900' of Type A curb and gutter
- 5,000' of 5½' P.C. sidewalk abutting curb
- 1,200' of 6' curb sidewalk
- 2,100' of road widening and pavement overlay, and all materials related thereto.

The location of the works are:

- (a) Moscrop Drive - from Willingdon Avenue to Wayburne Drive; 5½' concrete sidewalks abutting curb on the north side - a distance of approximately 1320'.
- (b) Moscrop Drive - from Wayburne Drive to Royal Oak Avenue on the north side only; approximately 900 lin. feet of Type A-curb and gutter and 5½' sidewalks abutting curb, 1,200 lin. feet of 6' curb sidewalk, 2,100' of pavement widening.
- (c) Royal Oak Avenue - Moscrop Drive and Gilpin Street intersection - Traffic Island relocation and overlay.
- (d) Willingdon Avenue - Lougheed Highway to Willingdon Avenue overpass; 5½' sidewalks abutting curb on both sides, approximately 2,800 lin. feet.

Each part of the work shall be completed in accordance with the following schedule:

(a) Moscrop Drive - Willingdon Avenue to Wayburne Drive	1 May 1972
(b) Moscrop Drive - Wayburne Drive to Royal Oak Avenue	1 May 1972
(c) Royal Oak Avenue - Moscrop Drive and Gilpin Street intersection	1 May 1972
(d) Willingdon Avenue - Lougheed Highway to Overpass	15 June 1972

The Engineer's comparative estimate for the work is \$74,878.00.

Five tenders were received and opened in the presence of V. D. Kennedy, C. R. Walters, R. J. Constable, K. Williams and representatives of the bidding firms.

A tabulation of the tenders received is attached.

The Purchasing Agent and Municipal Engineer recommend acceptance of the lowest bid which was received from Castle Concrete Ltd., in the sum of \$78,394.00 with final payment to be based on the actual quantities and the unit prices tendered per item.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the lowest tender being that of Castle Concrete Ltd. for the sum of \$78,394.00 be approved, with final payment to be based on the actual quantities and the unit prices tendered per item.
