10. Re: Rezoning Reference #1/72 Forest Lawn Housing Development "Green Tree Village"

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At the Public Hearing held November 28 in connection with the captioned rezoning application, a question was raised concerning the standard of roads to be provided within the project. The following is a summary of the standards incorporated in the design:

- 1. Public collector road 66-foot right-of-way, full 36-foot pavement standard with concrete curb and gutter each side; separated 6-foot concrete sidewalk 4 feet from curb, one side only; 10-foot offset from property line to road or edge of sidewalk on east and west sides respectively; boulevard to be grassed and planted with suitable boulevard trees by developer.
  - Public internal street (cul-de-sac) 50-foot right-of-way, full 28-foot pavement standard with concrete curb and gutter each side; separated 4-foot concrete sidewalk 4 feet from curb, one side only; 7 foot offset from property line to road or edge of sidewalk, respectively; boulevard to be grassed and planted with suitable boulevard trees by developer.

Cul-de-sac bulb 37'radius to inside of curb face.

 Private (strata title) internal streets - 20-foot minimum pavement width, concrete curb and gutter one side, 4-foot concrete curb walk opposite side.

cul-de-sac bulb 30' minimum radius.

- 4. Ornamental residential street lighting is to be provided throughout, with wiring and all services located underground.
- 5. Provision of the services and improvements listed above is to be the responsibility of the developer.
