An adjourned meeting of Council was held in the Council Chambers at 9.12 p.m. on May 4, 1972.

The Medical Health Officer submitted a report relative to the disposal of household waste, recommending that for individual control of household waste during the absence of municipal refuse pick-up service, the following procedure be followed:

**Burning:** All paper waste with the following exception:

- (1) Newspapers - packaged into units, tied securely and stored.

**Household Garbage:**

- (1) Wash cans well - remove both ends, if possible - crush and store in plastic bags.
- (2) Waste - place in plastic bag, tie neck of bag securely and store, preferably under cover. (Do not rip or tear plastic bag).
- (3) No composting of household waste due to possible rodent or fly infestation - odor.

**MOVED BY ALDERMAN LADNER, SECONDED BY ALDERMAN BLAIR:**

"That the report of the Medical Health Officer be received."
