

21. Re: Letter From Mrs. Vera E. Davies, 4247 Albert Street
3800 Block Hastings Street
Hastings Street Urban Redevelopment Scheme

Council on October 30, 1972, received a letter dated October 17, 1972, from Mrs. Vera E. Davies. Mrs. Davies suggested that the subject land not be used for park purposes, but that it be developed in a way that will produce tax revenue. Council subsequently instructed the Director of Planning to forward a reply to Mrs. Davies, and to submit a report on November 6, 1972, on the results of the invitation to tender on a proposal to develop land on the south side of the 3800 and 3900 blocks of Hastings Street.

The Director of Planning advises that

"the competition was closed on Tuesday and we have not as yet had an opportunity to meet with the other partners and are not therefore in a position to provide any information to Council on this matter. We have provided the Federal and Provincial representatives with some material and will be discussing it with them in the near future. Once we have had these discussions, we will be in a position to submit a progress report to Council."
