REMARKS: At 11:30 A.M. 9 FEB 73 a 45 year-old man broke into a Burnaby home, threatened the occupants with a gun and forced a 19 year-old former girlfriend to accompany him in his car. The girl was released unharmed near her residence the same evening. The culprit was found dead in a Vancouver hotel on 11 FEB 73 and it appears that he took his own life by selfadministering an overdose of drugs. There were eleven robberies reported during the month. These were all of a minor nature and similar to offences occurring in other municipalities in the Greater Vancouver area. To date we have successfully concluded five of the robberies and others are being actively investigated.

One reported rape was investigated and it has been established that the alleged offence did not occur, - charges are being considered against the complainant for public wischief.
