29. Re: Street Light Improvement on Willingdon Avenue

Mrs. D. Gebbie of 5136 Willingdon Avenue has requested the Municipality to improve the quality of street lighting on Willingdon Avenue between Moscrop and Grange Streets.

B.C. Hydro in a letter dated December 28, 1972, advised the Engineer that lighting can be improved without cost to the Municipality for the installation. There will however be an increased cost in yearly lease rental of \$1,174.92.

Old Rate: 16 - 300W M.V. \$ 836.64 per annum

New Rate: 31 - 450W M.V. \$ 2,011.56 per annum

Following for approval of Council is the Engineer's request. regarding the subject improvement:

"Willingdon Avenue - Moscrop to Grange Streets
(B.C. Hydro lease lighting):

"Upgrade 16 existing 300 Watt M.V. lamps to 31 - 450 Watt M.V. lamps."

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT approval be given for the subject lighting improvement.
