REMARKS:

There were five armed robberies at small business premises in Burnaby during the month. Four of these have now been solved and Court action is pending. Our investigators are continuing their investigation into the one remaining unsolved.

Approximately \$50,000 worth of stolen electronic equipment was recovered from a Burnaby warehouse, and two persons have been charged with possession and Court action is pending. Drug enforcement has been active during the month with a number of charges ensuing.
