2. Re: Ontario Crown Attorneys' Association Seminar on Law

The Ontario Crown Attorneys' Association is sponsoring two separate one-week seminars on a wide variety of matters pertaining to law at Massey College in Ontario. Mr. W. Stirling, the Municipal Solicitor-Prosecutor, has requested authority to attend one of the two seminars which are scheduled to be conducted from August 20 through August 24 and from August 27 through August 31, 1973.

The seminars are designed to provide lawyers with timely information on several important aspects of law including discovery and disclosure in criminal cases, criminal proceedings after committal for trial, drugs (innocence and guilt), medical evidence, the defence, Judge's charge, statements and their use, recent developments in legislation, the future of criminal law, etc. The seminars have also been structured to allow participants to exchange ideas and information through the discussion of subjects that are of common interest to them.

The total estimated cost of attending the seminar is \$384.00 (the estimate includes an established cost of only \$30.00 for one week's accommodation at the College).

RECOMMENDATIONS:
