COUNCIL MEETING Nov. 19/73

25. Re: Petition from Eleven Residents on Piper Avenue
Local Improvement Program

Appearing on the Agenda for the March 19, 1973 meeting of Council is a petition from eleven residents on Piper Avenue for an amendment to the 1972 Local Improvement Program. The petitioners request that twenty-eight foot pavement with curbs only be provided on Piper Avenue between Government and Winston Streets as an alternative to twenty-eight foot pavement with five foot curb sidewalks, and that the alternate proposal proceed in accordance with the former time schedule.

It will not be possible to re-design, reinitiate and still meet the former time schedule as the work program is an on-going process. Time schedules and deadlines must be maintained or else the whole program becomes jeopardized. There are several Departments involved plus much paper work.

A report on the subject request and other Local Improvement Projects which should go forth will be submitted to Council on April 2, 1973.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the petitioners be advised that their request for an amendment to the 1972 Local Improvement Program will be considered by Council on April 2, 1973, but that we cannot meet the former time schedule.
