## 5. Re: B.C. Hydro Overhead Lighting on Sprott Street Between Douglas Road and Norland Avenue

Because of an anticipated increased pedestrian use of the above street associated with the increased sporting facilities in the Central Valley Sports Complex area, coupled with the present lack of adequate walking facilities, (a Local Improvement initiation is proposed in 1974, which does not include street lighting) B.C. Hydro was asked for an estimate to upgrade the present lease lighting.

B.C. Hydro is prepared to install ten additional 450 M.V. lease lights to their wood poles at an average spacing of 160 feet at no additional cost to the Municipality other than the normal existing lease rate which would amount to \$679.80 per year.

## RECOMMENDATION:

THAT B.C. Hydro be requested to install ten additional 450 M.V. lease lights.
