COUNCIL MEETING Jan. 22/73

16. Re: Letter from Mr. J. Postnikoff, 4021 Curle Avenue
Case: Drive-In Theatre

Appearing on the Agenda for the January 22, 1973 meeting of Council is a letter dated November 14, 1972 from Mr. J. Postnikoff regarding the Cascades Drive-In Theatre which is located at 4021 Curle Avenue (the letter from Mr. Postnikoff was not referred to Council until this time because it had been inadvertently mislaid in the Clerk's office).

The Engineer and the Officer in Charge, Burnaby Detachment, R.C.M.P., advise that the installation of "No Parking Anytime" signs near the intersection of 4021 Curle Avenue and Avondale would be a deterrent to the parking problem and could be enforced by members of the R.C.M.P.

The crosshatched areas on the attached sketch show the positions from where persons in parked vehicles are observing scenes on the movie screen and where restricted parking regulations should be imposed. Mr. Postnikoff's property is Lot 51 (marked A). The occupant who lives on Lot 12 (marked B) was contacted regarding the complaint and is in favor of the parking ban adjacent to his property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT appropriate "No Parking" signs be installed in the areas shown on the attached sketch; and

THAT copies of this report be sent to Mr. Postnikoff and the owner of the dwelling on Lot 12.
