34. Re: U.B.C.M. Resolutions

Item 28 of the Manager's Report contains six proposed resolutions for referral to the U.B.C.M. Following is an additional resolution regarding installation of gas mains by the B. C. Hydro and Power Authority:

WHEREAS, the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority installs gas mains in streets within the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS, services are required to deliver natural gas to properties abutting such streets;

AND WHEREAS, B.C. Hydro and Power Authority has on such streets only one gas main;

AND WHEREAS, B.C. Hydro and Power Authority does not have a policy of pre-servicing such properties, necessitating cutting across pavements, curbs and sidewalks which in many instances have just been newly constructed;

AND WHEREAS, a gas main located on both sides of a street near the property lines would obviate the necessity of making such cuts across the street;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the U.B.C.M. approach the Provincial Government requesting that B.C. Hydro and Power Authority be asked to adopt a general policy of installing gas mains on both sides of streets, whether such streets are existing or are newly-created.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the subject resolution be approved for referral to the U.B.C.M.
