Appearing on the Agenda for the February 26, 1973, meeting of Council is a letter dated February 22, 1973, from Mr. Hugh Cooper to the Clerk. Mr. Cooper has requested permission to appear as a delegation on February 26, 1973, to speak in opposition of Rezoning Reference #54/72 which involves a rezoning and proposed lease of park land to accommodate an overhead conveyor for Kask Bros. Ready Mix Concrete.
