Following for your information is the report of the Medical Health Officer covering the activities of his Department for the Month of February, 1973.

MONTHLY REPORT

Dear Sir:

I have the pleasure of submitting a report for this Department for the month of February 1973.

A newly diagnosed active case of tuberculosis was discovered in McPherson Secondary School. This student has been admitted to hospital and plans are now underway to skin test the students and teachers in the school. Notifications and consent forms will be sent to all parents in preparation for the clinic which will be held early in March. Students who have a positive skin reaction will be referred for chest x-rays. Also, a man who is a non resident of Burnaby but who works in a Burnaby plant was diagnosed as an active tuberculosis case this month. The Health Department personnel carried out a skin testing clinic in this plant where 41 employees were skin tested. Six people with positive reactions were followed up with chest x-rays.

The Windsor dental clinic conducted a dental survey of all kindergarten children in Board schools in the South Burnaby area. Where dental care was indicated, the usual notices went out to the parents advising them of their choice between the school board dental care or their own private dentist.

Recently eight first year B. C. I. T. students visited the Environmental Health section of the Department for field work and instruction by the Public Health Inspectors, on typical district work, this included routine restaurant inspections.

The communicable diseases reported for the month of February showed a slight increase over the previous month with 217 cases reported. Of these there were 104 chickenpox, 87 mumps, 8 pediculosis, 5 ringworm, 4 infectious hepatitis, 3 scarlet fever, 2 salmonellosis and I each tuberculosis, impetigo, conjunctivitis and scabies,
