

1. Re: Canadian Parks and Recreation National Convention

By correspondence dated July 20, 1973, from the Acting Secretary of the Parks and Recreation Commission to the Municipal Manager, the Parks and Recreation Commission requests approval from Council to have the following two Commissioners attend the Canadian Parks and Recreation National Convention in Regina, Saskatchewan from August 19 through August 23, 1973:

The total estimated cost per person is as follows:

Air Fare - Return	\$164.00
Registration Fee	45.00
Per Diem Rate - 5 days @ \$60.00	<u>300.00</u>
Total	<u>\$509.00</u>

The total estimated cost for the two Commissioners to attend the five day convention is \$1,018.00.

The Commission advises that there are sufficient funds available in the Budget to cover the proposed cost.

For information of Council, the per diem rate of \$60.00 per day provides for accommodation, meals, and incidentals such as taxi fare and parking fees, and is the same per diem rate as that available to Council members while attending conventions and conferences.
