9. Re: Kinsmen Club of North Burnaby Request for a Trailer

The following communication has been received from the Kinsmen Club of North Burnaby.

"Further to our telephone conversation 25 April 1973, we understand there is a small trailer, suitable for parade floats, to be disposed of soon by auction. Our service club has been hoping to acquire something like this, but funds for other than service work are hard to come by, so we have not been able to build one.

When we heard of this one through the parks' board, we wondered if we may purchase it for a nominal amount so that we could use it for future parades.

For many years our club has represented Burnaby, in our own association functions, such as the Annual District Kinvention being held in Kelowna, this May 24th weekend.

There are many public functions held each year in neighbouring municipalities where we could also be able to participate in if we had a trailer.

We appreciate any consideration you may be able to give us on this."

We have on hand a trailer that was bought for use as a float many years ago. It has an approximate value of \$200. It is the trailer mentioned in the letter but it is not on the Parks Board inventory. It is surplus.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the trailer be sold for the sum of \$1.00 to the Kinsmen Club of North Burnaby for use as a float.
