
Subject: Burnaby Sign By-law 1972

This Department was asked by Council to report after six months following passage of the Sign By-law of any problems of by-law enforcement arising from the requirement of Section 3(3) of the By-law.

"...any sign lawfully in existence at the time of the adoption of this By-law shall not be rebuilt, reconstructed, altered or moved unless in conformity with the provisions of this By-law, and the contrary shall be unlawful."
