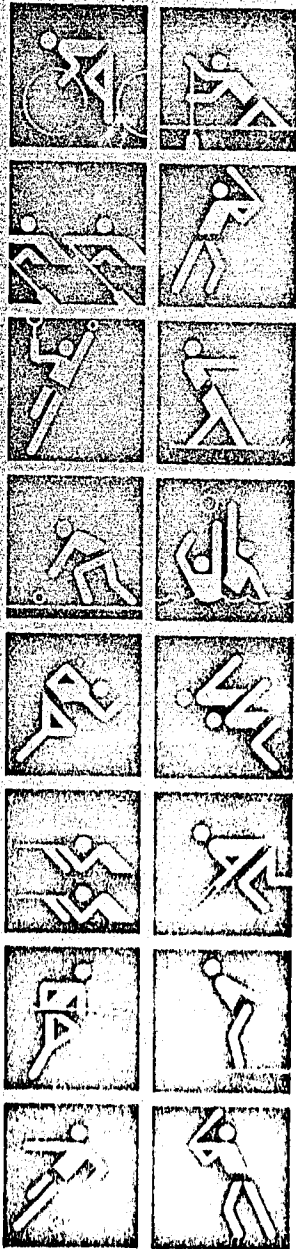

As part of the 1973 Canada Summer Games Official Opening Ceremonies, the Games are planning a Canadian Forces Fly Pass at approximately 7:45 p.m. August 3, 1973. The fly pass will consist of four Voodoo High Performance Jet Aircraft from CFB Comox. The flight plan will consist of one pass from South to North over Queens Park Stadium at an altitude of approximately 500 feet. We are asking your support in this project.

If favorable consent is given to this request would you please direct the necessary approval to the Ministry of Transport, 793 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, B.C. Attention: Mr. A. Gill.
