COUNCIL MEETING June 10/74

Emissions of Noise from Motorcycles in the  
Stride Avenue Area  
(Item 16, Report No. 41, May 27, 1974)

Council, at its meeting of May 27, 1974, received the above-noted report which advised that the Chief Public Health Inspector anticipated submitting a report for the June 10, 1974 meeting of Council which would show that motorcycle use of the Stride gravel pit area constitutes a nuisance to persons who reside in nearby residential areas.

The Chief Public Health Inspector now advises that field studies and analyses of sound readings clearly indicate that noise from motorcycles at the Stride area are a nuisance to neighbouring residents and do exceed levels as permitted under the Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-law.

With respect to enforcement and administration, the Chief Public Health Inspector advises that examination of the legal ramifications of enforcement must be finalized. It is anticipated that a full report will be provided to Council at its meeting of July 17, 1974.
