15. Re: Tenders for Steel Water Pipe - Big Bend Area

For the information of Council, tenders were called last year for the supply and installation of pipe in the subject area. Tenders closed on December 12, 1973. Because staff believed that a major impediment to would-be tenders was the prevailing uncertainty with respect to price and delivery date for pipe and fittings, it was considered necessary for the Municipality to undertake the purchase of the necessary materials, and then recall tenders only for the related installation. We therefore did not report to Council but rather called tenders for the supply of the pipe only.

It is proposed that tenders for the construction of mains be called again at a later date when the pipe has been delivered.

Following is a report from the Purchasing Agent regarding tenders for the steel water pipe for the Big Bend Area as shown on the <u>attached</u> sketch.

The Engineer concurs with the recommendation to purchase the pipe from the lowest bidders.

Comco Distributors Limited has extended the period during which their tender will remain firm. The period has been extended from February 8, as noted on the tabulation, to February 12, 1974.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT the tender for 12" ID pipe in the amount of \$27,284.00 plus 5% S.S. tax from ITT Grinnell Sales Limited be accepted; and

THAT the tender for 18" OD pipe in the amount of \$100,435.00 plus 5% S.S. tax from Comco Distributors Limited be accepted; and

THAT authorization be given to expend approximately \$2,000 for costs associated with the delivery of all the pipe; and

THAT tenders be called for the installation of the pipe when delivery is made.

Sealed tenders for the subject pipe were received up to 3:00 p.m., local time, Wednesday, January 30, 1974.

The tender is for the supply and delivery of 5,300 ft of 18" steel pipe and 3,100 ft of 12" steel pipe to be lined and wrapped, complete with couplings.

Four tenders were received and opened in the presence of Messrs. Constable, Hagen and representatives of the firms bidding.


Submitted <u>herewith</u> is a correct tabulation of the tenders received; no bid bonds or performance bonds were requested.

The lowest bid offered, conforming to our specifications on the 12" pipe, was submitted by ITT Grinnell Sales Ltd. for \$27,284.00 plus 5% S.S. Tax. The lowest bid to our specifications on the 18" pipe, was submitted by Comco Distributors Ltd. for \$100,435.00 plus 5% S.S. Tax.

I would recommend that two contracts be issued for this material, one to ITT Grinnell Sales Ltd. for the 12" pipe, the other to Comeo Distributors Ltd. for the 18" pipe at their tendered prices (both companies have agreed to accept a part of the total tender).

Local delivery is still a variable cost. A point of delivery has not been established due to the fact that the installation contract has not been negotiated. However, in any event, it should not exceed \$2,000.00 for all the pipe.
