MRS. E. M. DOWLING - REQUEST FOR SIDEWALKS ON WILLINGTON AVENUE, RE: PANDORA STREET TO ETON STREET - COST ESTIMATE.

As requested by the Municipal Council at its meeting of 25 February, 1974 we wish to report that the estimated cost of a chip screenings sidewalk on the west side of Willingdon Avenue between Eton Street and Pandora Street is \$4,000.

In order for a possible warrant for the facility to be established I requested the "Sidewalk Sub-Committee" of the Traffic Safety Committee to convene themselves and to provide me with their thoughts on the need for such a sidewalk in the captioned location. The Sub-Committee has conducted its investigation and has recommended to me that there is a need for a sidewalk.

Recommendation: THAT a chip screenings sidewalk be constructed on the west side of Willingdon Avenue from Eton Street to Pandora Street, and,

THAT the estimated cost of \$4,000. to construct the chip screenings walk be charged to Budget Code 15-06, Special Roads Projects, and,
