Re: Undated Letter from Mr. P.A. Scott Heritage Village Master Development Plan

Appearing on the agenda for the May 13, 1974 meeting of Council is a letter from Mr. P.A. Scott, Executive Director of Heritage Village, regarding further development of the Village in accordance with a master plan.

The Parks and Recreation Commission considered the master plan supplied by the Century Park Museum Association on December 5, 1973. The staff was subsequently directed to study the plan in some considerable detail. As a result of this effort, a report on the matter will be referred to the Commission on June 5, 1974. It is anticipated that Council will receive comments on the Commission's examination and evaluation of the report and plan shortly thereafter.

In summary, it would be premature for Council to provide specific comments on the statements contained in Mr. Scott's letter at this time. It is suggested that Council receive Mr. Scott's letter, and defer further consideration of the plan until such time that the Commission reports on its deliberations in this regard.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT a copy of Mr. Scott's undated letter be referred to the Parks and Recreation Commission for study and recommendation with respect to:

(a) The "Master Plan" itself and its cost,

(b) The method and timing of financing the development proposed by the Century Park Museum Association including the sharing of fiscal responsibility; and

THAT a copy of this report be sent to the Century Park Museum Association.
