REMARKS:

The revenue under Municipal fines totalling over \$20,000 represents fines received during April which had been levied prior to April 1st with time to pay, and are therefore payable to the Municipality.

An armed robbery of a jewellery store on Kingsway resulted in the culprit being arrested after a police car chase, and recovery of stolen goods and cash. The matter is still under investigation. Cooperation of the Vancouver City Police during the chase assisted in the successful conclusion.

A corner grocery armed robbery at gunpoint involved theft of \$55.00 in cash by a culprit believed to be in his early teens.

There was one fatal motor vehicle accident during the month when a child ran out into the street from his yard and was hit by a pick-up truck.

There was a slightly higher than average number of impaired driving charges during the month.
