REMARKS:

One fatality during the month - passenger killed when collision occurred between two vehicles. Both drivers were impaired and both have been charged.

There was quite an increase in motor vehicle accidents during the month of March with no specific pattern. There was an increased number of impaired charges processed and also an increase in the number of breathalyzer tests taken.

A subject was arrested in connection with a number of child molesting incidents which transpired during the last several months.

Two cases of purse snatching and several evening robberies of service stations, grocery and drug stores were investigated during the month. Extraordinary preventative patrols have been carried out to combat these incidents. One man has been arrested and five charges laid.
