RE: RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION - HALLEY AVENUE AT SARDIS STREET

The Engineer has determined that 17 feet is required off the front of three lots on Halley Avenue at Sardis Street for road widening purposes related to the proposed Local Improvement project in the 1974-75 program on Halley Avenue from Grange Street to Burke Street (see plan attached). The Land Agent has been attempting to negotiate these acquisitions, however it is impossible to prepare documents until a road acquisition and dedication by-law has been passed and filed in the Land Registry Office. This by-law does not in any way bind the Corporation to carry out the acquisitions and the individual acquisitions will be brought before Council in the normal manner as negotiations proceed.

RECOMMENDATION:

That By-Law No. 6599, being "Burnaby Road Acquisition and Dedication By-Law No. 4, 1974", relating to the three acquisitions, be given three readings.
